RBVRR Women's College endeavors to achieve its vision of providing quality education to women. In a world characterized by exponential change, design and development of new programs/courses has become an imperative need. Introduction of innovative and need based courses, therefore has emerged as the priority area of the college.

The College has identified Forensic Science as the thrust area in its perspective plan, due to its wide spread applications in the field of investigative science, contributing to Global and National security.

RBVRR Women's College is the first college in South India to introduce Forensic Science at Undergraduate level(B.Sc) in the academic year 2014-2015.

Facilities: State of the art Crime Scene Training facilities and Crime Laboratories in collaboration with premier institutions, are used to train students in the practices of Modern Forensics. In addition, students can take a variety of forensic courses in other disciplines such as Anthropology, Criminal Justice, Policing and Law, Criminal Psychology, Human Rights, Cyber Forensic etc.

The progress (performance) of the course in the last five years is presented below:

- The demand ratio of the course has increased from 1:2 in 2014-2015 to 1:5 in 2019-2020
- The course is sought by meritorious students from across the country, with 92% marks as the least mark, in the admitted list.
- The student strength of the course has increased from 60 in 2014-2015 to 100 in 2019-2020.
